Abstract

In the fiscal year 2013/2014, Child Helpline Nepal 1098 recorded 37,894 calls altogether in 5 helplines, run by CWIN in 5 different districts of Nepal. The calls included 11,452 calls from boys, 10,884 calls from girls and 12,558 calls were silent. Likewise, 4,282 children (1,788 girls) called helpline themselves to share their problems and report their concern. The problems of the children which were shared on the hotline telephone mainly included request for support/help (562), shelter (211), lost and found cases (672), labor exploitation (134), sexual abuse (115) and physical abuse (77). The other problems, which are though small in number but are serious ones, include child marriage (67), child trafficking (23), drug abuse (14) and online abuse (29). Many children also called child helpline to get information about child rights, helpline and CWIN (7194) and also to get information about other NGOs (1664).

Similarly, Child Helpline provided direct support to 1,824 children (807 girls) in the last fiscal year. Most of the children whom helpline supported belonged to the age group 11-13 years (536) followed by 14-16 years (526) and 6-10 years (494). The helpline supported the children from all sort of background majority of them being student (1254), hotel worker (114) and domestic worker (94). Likewise, children working as a transportation worker (18) and street children (39) were also provided with different emergency support and services as per their need and circumstances.

On the other hand, the information from stakeholders is serving helpline to know about the problem and serious issues of the children. Child Helpline received information about the children cases from police (257), school (172), print media (40), other NGOs (130), DCWB (115), Khoj Talash (44) and so on. The information disseminated by helpline about child rights and helpline during family reintegration, education support programs, campaigns and so on, has helped helpline to sensitize different groups of people like family, relatives, community etc. As a result, helpline got information about many cases from family (94), relatives (33) and community (210) themselves.

In addition, in the last fiscal year, the majority of the cases dealt by helpline include physical abuse (91), sexual abuse (98), labor exploitation (166), lost and found cases (368), education support (405), trafficking (142), child delinquency (40), and child marriage (44). In this connection, helpline provided services like emergency rescue (290), emergency shelter (605), ambulance/vehicle service (389), medical first aid service (141), treatment in hospital (61), emergency support (416), psycho-social counseling (1154), legal service (161), family reintegration (392), referral (398), education support (335), vocational training (39) and initiation to search missing children (196).
